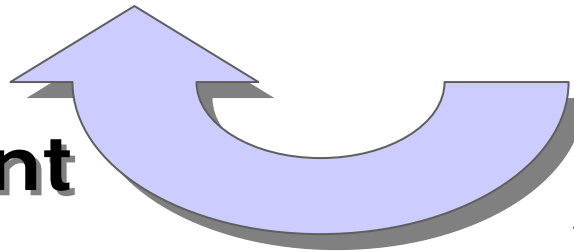

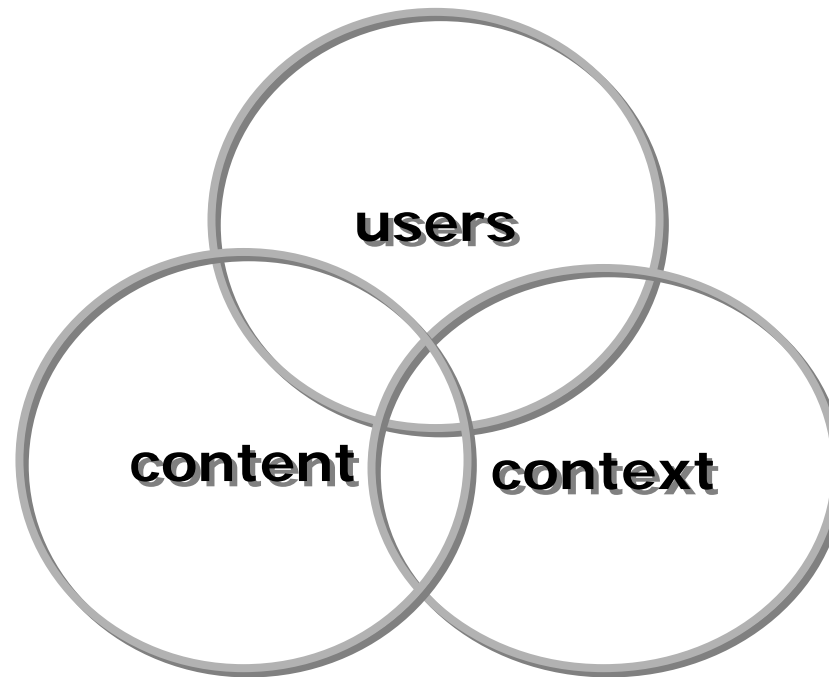

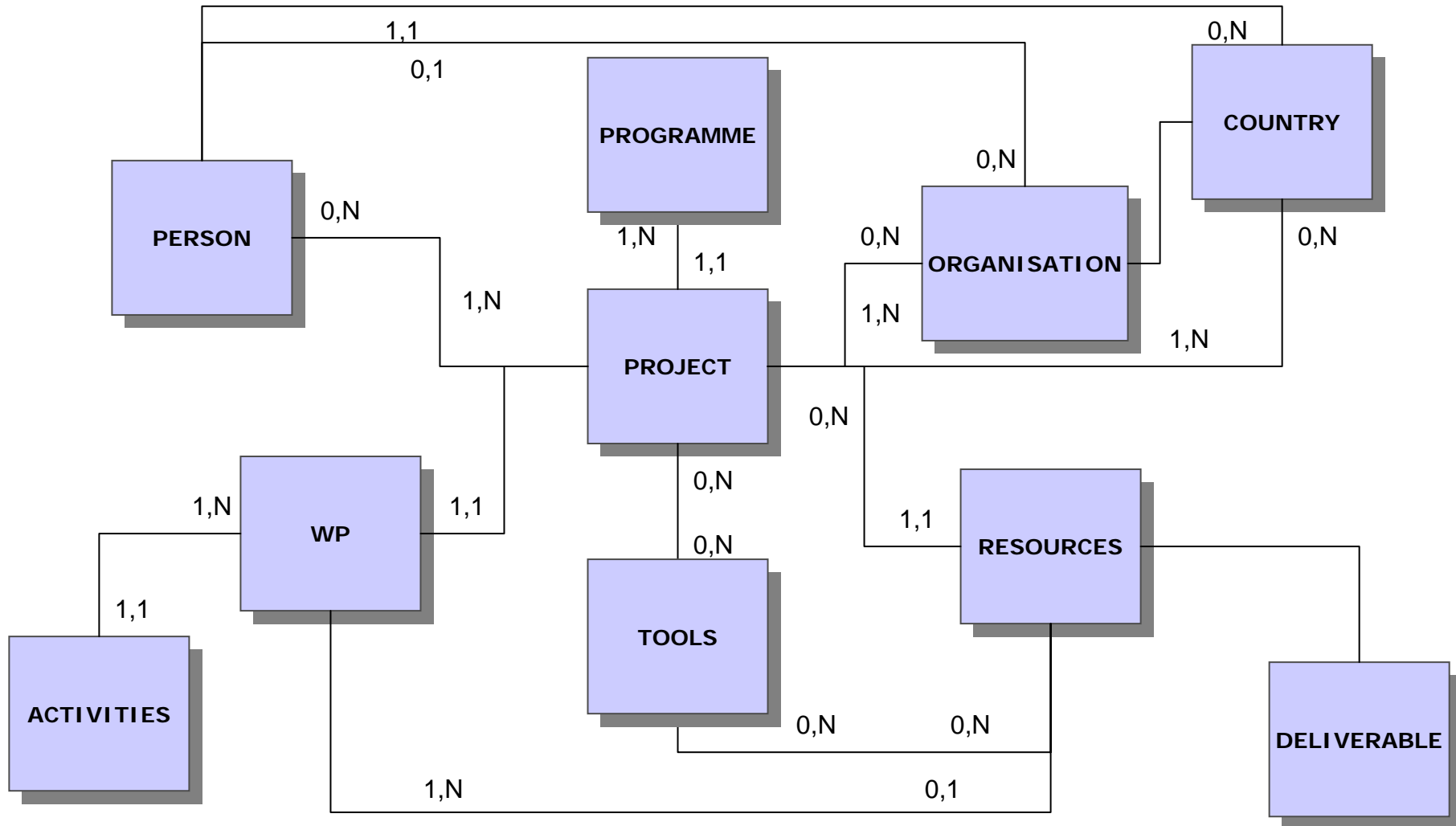
- Centralised/structured information

The project as core entity

- A project is part of a programme
- Projects gather partners (consortium) under common goals, objectives and expected results to attend within its lifetime
- To achieve goals activities are organised in workpackages lead by one or more partners
- Activities must be monitored and coordinated
- Many persons participate to a project with different roles (participants, trainees, scientific advisors) and organisations
- A project implements or uses tools (models, db, DSS, GIS, methods)
- A project produces resources (data, information, reports, analysis, synthesis...)

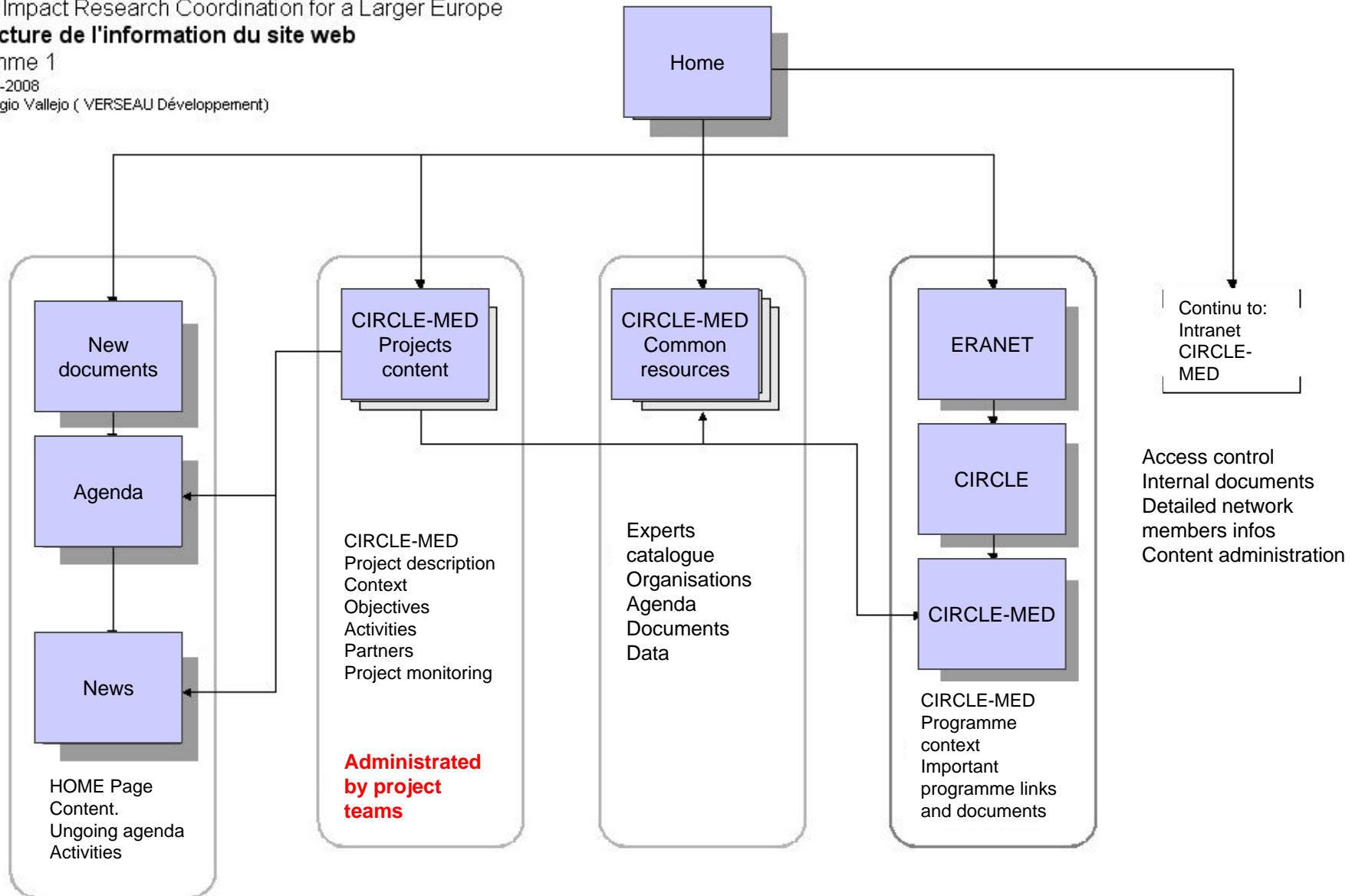

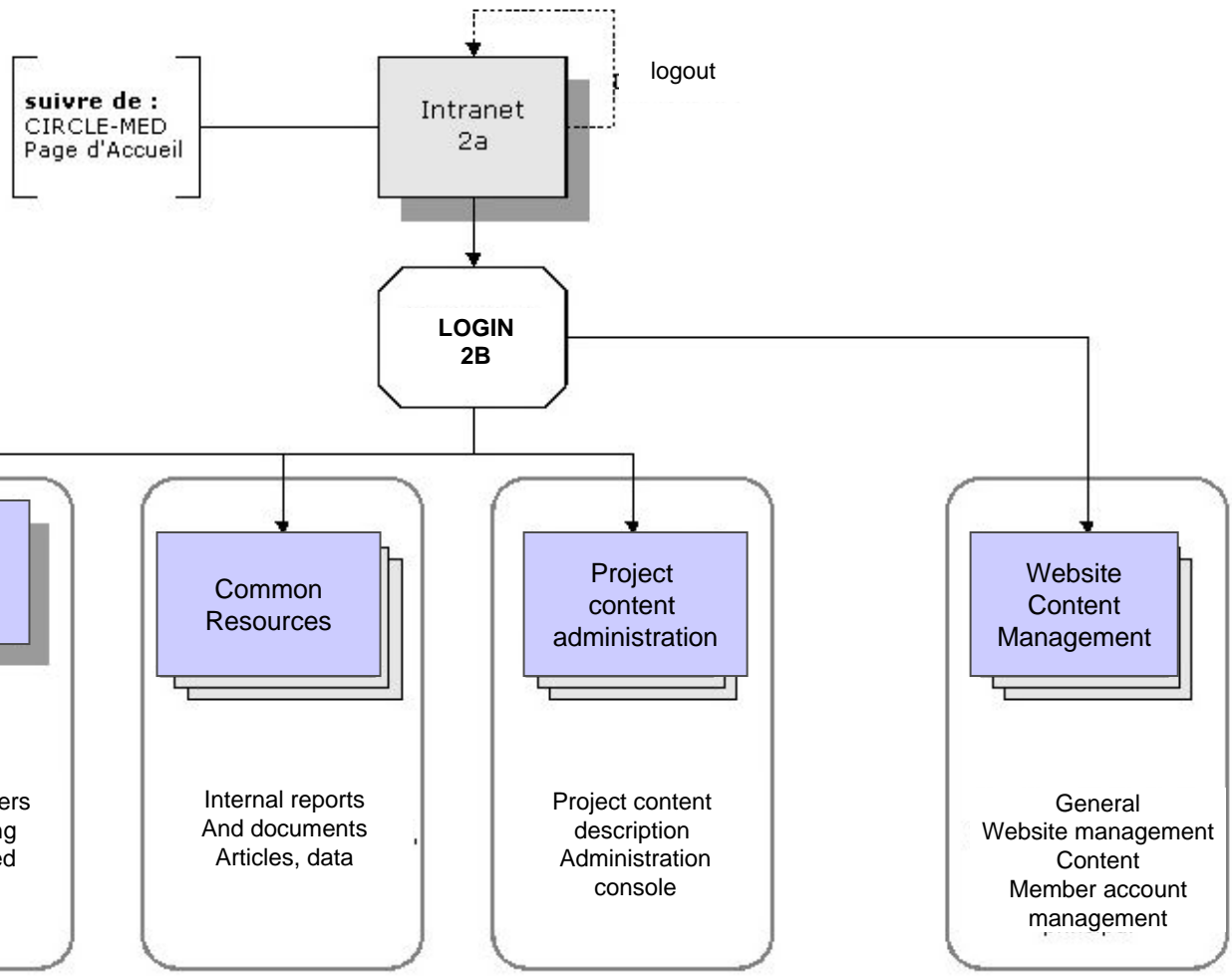
